


#### What is Integrated Pest Management?


IPM is a science-based decision-making process that reduces risks from pests and pest management strategies. Using pest biology, environmental data, and all available technologies, IPM prevents unacceptable levels of pest damage in the most economical way, while minimizing risks to people, property, resources, and the environment. It's an approach to pest-management that can be used in any environment or endeavor.

#### What is the Public IPM Enterprise?

In university laboratories and research and extension centers around the nation, IPM practices are developed, tested and promoted by researchers and specialists in agriculture, natural areas, and urban and rural communities. This effort spans hundreds of institutions and several scientific specialties. IPM education is provided by Land-Grant Universities, including 1864s, Tribal Colleges (1994s), Historically Black Colleges and Universities, and Hispanic-Serving Institutions. There are 53 state IPM programs and four Regional IPM Centers, primarily supported by USDA-NIFA's Crop Protection and Pest Management program, but historically there has been little long-term planning or concerted, collective efforts to expand IPM's reach and impact.
